The ATASCOSA Rural WSC water system PWS ID 0150040 has violated the REPORTING requirement set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) IN Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether your water is safe from microbial contamination.

These violations occurred in the monitoring periods of the first and second quarters of 2025.

We are taking the following action to address this issue:
